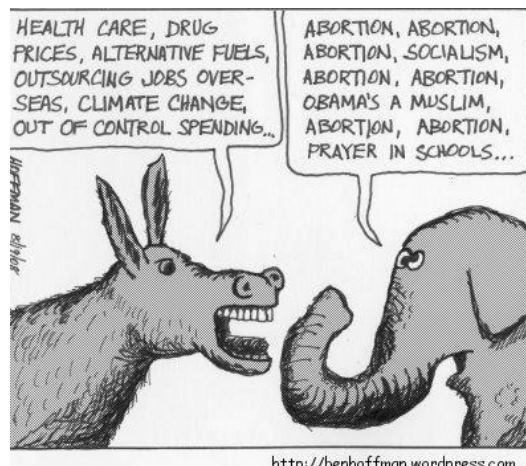

Miranda Ko, Speaker, Climate Reality

Miranda Ko was born and raised in Hong Kong, and attended school in Tokyo before coming to California. One of the youngest trained presenters under Al Gore, Miranda has already worked at Sanyo, Clinton Global Initiative University, and Scripps Institution of Oceanography at UCSD. Miranda currently attends the University of California, San Diego under a full scholarship. She studied at Stanford University.

Besides the environment, Miranda turns to her second passion, television and print. Having appeared in Women's Health, Brides Magazine, Sears, Intel, Party City, Northface, and Adidas, Miranda is a top model and news personality whose work has aired in Hong Kong, Japan, California, and New York. Today Miranda travels exclusively with Nintendo Gaming to their largest Press Events, such as E3 and Comic Con. Miranda speaks four languages: Mandarin, Cantonese, Japanese, and English.

In 2011, Miranda was awarded "the Green Goddess" by Women's Health Magazine for her work with Al Gore and The Climate Reality Project, working as the Assistant District Manager for Southern California. In 2012, she was awarded "Climate Queen" by the California Center for Sustainable Energy. She taught a course at the University of California, San Diego on presentation skills and personal branding.

Miranda now lives in San Diego, CA. She works as a Seismic Data Analyst at the Scripps Institution of Oceanography. In 2013, she was awarded the Outstanding Student Paper Award by the American Geophysical Union for her research in earthquakes.

Miranda's other job:

Seismic Data Analyst at Scripps Institution of Oceanography

The Array Network Facility component of the EarthScope USArray project is charged with ensuring all the real-time, seismic data collected from the Transportable Array and Flexible Arrays are transmitted, checked for quality, archived, and accessible online for researchers and the general public.

The facility is part of the Scripps Institution of Oceanography at the University of California, San Diego.

In Miranda's words:

I oversee and analyze all real-time data from over 500 earthquake and infrasound sensors to determine weather patterns and seismicity. I check for data anomalies and determine if a field team needs to go to the station site to replace the sensor. The USArray Network notifies researchers and the public on weather and seismic phenomenon by documenting them in our special events pages.

In January 2013, I was awarded the Outstanding Student Paper Award on the Preliminary Strategies to Automate Quality Control of Meteorological Data from the ANF USArray Network by AGU (American Geophysical Union).
